Introduction

Warehouse operations which are efficient and orderly tend to be safer and more successful. It is necessary for the employee to move and store the supplies throughout the facility in a timely and efficient manner. Because of the various activities involved within warehouse operations, employees in warehouse environment may be at greater risk for accidents than individuals who work in areas with more limited activities. Thus, companies place a top priority on warehouse safety.

Knowledge of potential warehouse hazards is key to preventing accidents. Always be alert to possible hazards and ways to reduce risks. Do whatever is necessary to avoid accidents.

General Hazards

Common kinds of danger in a warehouse environment are slips, trips and falls. These accidents are normally caused when employees lose their balance or stumble over a thing which has not been put away properly. Removing or placing things from storage can result in a fumble or slip, possibly causing both thing and employee to fall. The potential for trips, falls and slips is increased when workers are moving things on various kinds of floor surfaces and on different levels. Another common danger is getting hit by falling items. This is normally caused by failure to correctly stack stuff on shelves and other surfaces. Back injuries because of improper lifting techniques are another common danger.

There are inherent risks in using and working around workplace equipment. Accidents could normally be caused from the incorrect utilization of forklift trucks, conveyors and hand trucks. Warehouse tools, like for example pallets, skids, cutting and strapping tools, need to be used carefully in unpacking, packing and loading.

Dangerous substances, flammable or combustible materials can pose hazards while being stored in a warehouse. Workers should know how to take steps to protect themselves from health dangers while working around hazardous materials.
